The Stock family made a memorial donation to the FHAPA. Thank you for your kindness!

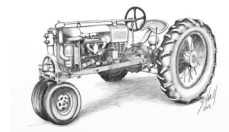
Our guest speaker was Sherri Ferguson who spoke about the early days of the city of Dunlap to present days. Thank you, Jim Schwindt for arranging this!

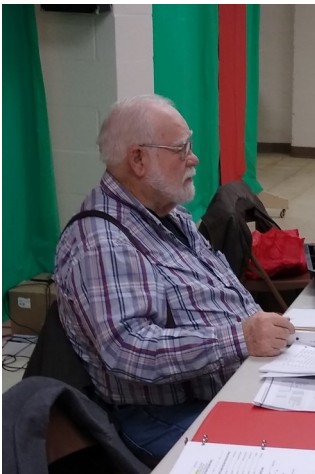
